Pre-Viewing and Discussion Questions

Grade Level: 3-5



Before watching...

Pre-viewing activities or discussions help focus attention when watching a video and build critical thinking skills. Consider using a simple activity such as defining the character word together or having students write their own definitions before watching the story.

After Watching...

Discussion Questions

1. The kids say that peace is “dealing with stuff and not trying to create chaos” and “getting along well.” How do you define peace?
2. One girl says when she thinks of the word peace she imagines a dove. When an object or a picture represents an idea or a concept it is called a symbol, so her symbol for peace is the dove. What are some other symbols for peace? Draw the symbols and share with the group.
3. One boy says that to have peace, people should not “get in fights.” Why?
4. The last girl to speak leaves us with the words, “We play fairly and when we have a problem we figure it out.” How do these two practices create peace?
