Dwayne

Grade Level: Middle School/High School

DU Theme: CRE, Mentorship

SEL Competency: Responsible Decision Making, Self-Management, Self-Awareness

Facilitator may wish to use reflection questions with students individually or in groups. Below is a possible adaptation for a group activity.

ACTIVITY

Ask students to think about the qualities they would expect to find in an adult mentor. After providing wait time, place students in groups of two or three and have students discuss the mentors we see in the video with Dwayne and what they do to help Dwayne decide to change the direction of his life. Ask groups to develop a list of the qualities good mentors should possess and once groups have done this have each group share with the larger group.

Ask probing questions about how Dwayne responded to the mentors we see in the video and what you would look for in a mentor for yourself. Why do you think the qualities your group mentions are important? If there are adult mentors in your life tell us about them.
